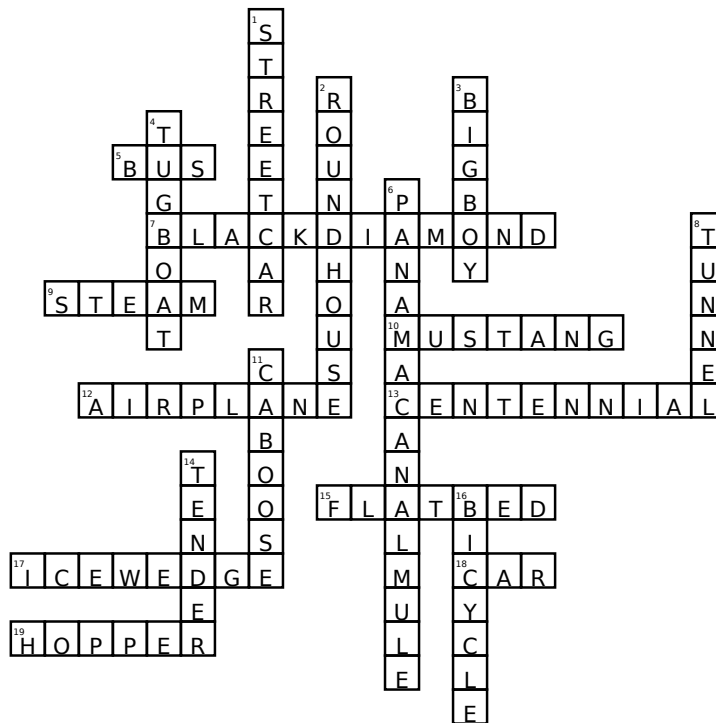


The National Museum of Transportation

14. purpose is to carry water and coal,
