

The National Museum of Transportation Mask Policy

Effective Thursday, May 20, 2021

Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear a mask indoors or outdoors at The National Museum of Transportation except when riding the miniature train or trolley. A supply of masks is available at both locations.

Drinking fountains will reopen on May 24, 2021.

Creation Station 'Boarding Time' capacity will increase to 30 per session on June 1, 2021.

Guided tours through passenger cars will resume on July 1, 2021. Tours are limited to six individuals plus the guide. **All** individuals on a passenger car tour must wear a mask.

Mezzanine capacity for events/meetings is 40.

All plexiglass barriers will remain in place until further notice.

All fully vaccinated staff, volunteers, and guests **may** continue to wear a mask and socially distance if they choose.

All non-vaccinated staff, volunteers, and guests, five years of age and older, **must** continue to wear a mask indoors and maintain social distancing with those individuals from outside of your household or group. All non-vaccinated staff, volunteers, and guests, five years of age and older, **must** wear a mask outdoors and maintain social distancing with those individuals from outside of your household or group.

We will continue to monitor CDC and state and local government announcements and adjust our policy when necessary.
