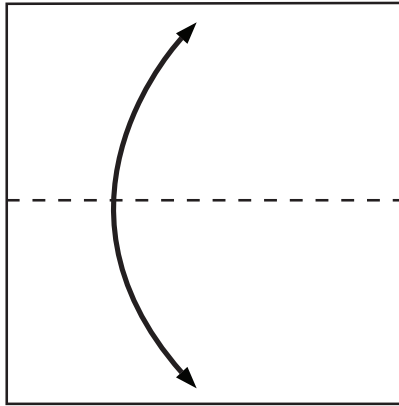

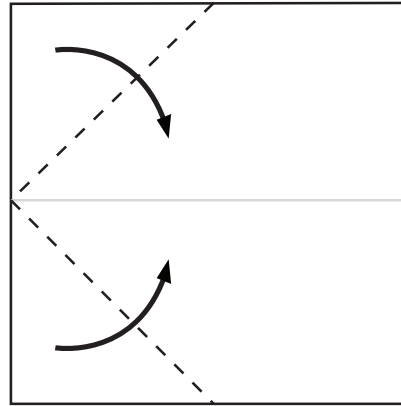

# Make A Paper Airplane

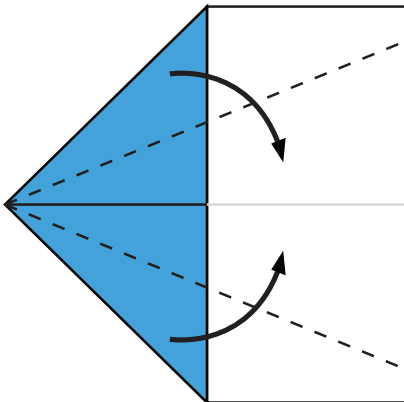
